Bird Search Scavenger Hunt

This scavenger hunt competition is to find birdy things around downtown Little Rock/North Little Rock. You don't have to know your birds, just use your eagle eyes!

Teams of 2-5 will compete to find the most birdy items on a list provided the day of BirdLR on May 12, 2018. Teams will convene at the Riverhouse (140 Riverfront Drive, North Little Rock) at 2:45pm to pick up the list, then reconvene there for the Bird Bash from 5-7pm for free food, drink, and prizes!

Registration deadline is May 9. Cost is \$25/team member. Indicate your team's name when you register. All members receive a BirdLR t-shirt.

Rules:

1. All team members must register by May 9.
2. Children 16 & under can join teams but are not registered team members.
3. No illegal activities
4. Only 1 car per team. Team members must stay together at all times.
5. Teams must start at the Riverhouse at 2:45pm on Saturday to review rules and receive clues.
6. Teams will be scored as they find items. Each item has a point value. Each team must have at least one phone capable of taking and texting photos of found items to Audubon's scorekeeper.
7. Photos of found items must be received by 5pm to be eligible for scoring.
8. The prize for most points will be awarded at the Bird Bash at the Riverhouse. At least one team member must be present to be eligible to win.

Your participation on a Scavenger Hunt team will benefit Audubon Arkansas's bird conservation and environmental education work. All funds raised through BirdLR will stay right here in Arkansas to help our native bird populations survive and thrive, and to inspire and educate current and future generations.
